Pursuant to California Department of Aging Program Memo 22-07 regarding Governor Newsom’s Executive Order N-6-22 (EO) regarding sanctions in response to Russian aggression in Ukraine, this Bulletin serves as official notification to all funded programs of their obligation to comply with sanctions imposed by the federal government and by the State of California.

Effective immediately, all funded programs shall:

1. Review all contracts for commodities, services, and technology to determine whether they comply with existing economic sanctions; and,
2. Terminate any contracts with any individuals or entities that are determined to be a target of economic sanctions; and,
3. Refrain from entering into any new contracts with such individuals or entities while economic sanctions are in effect.
