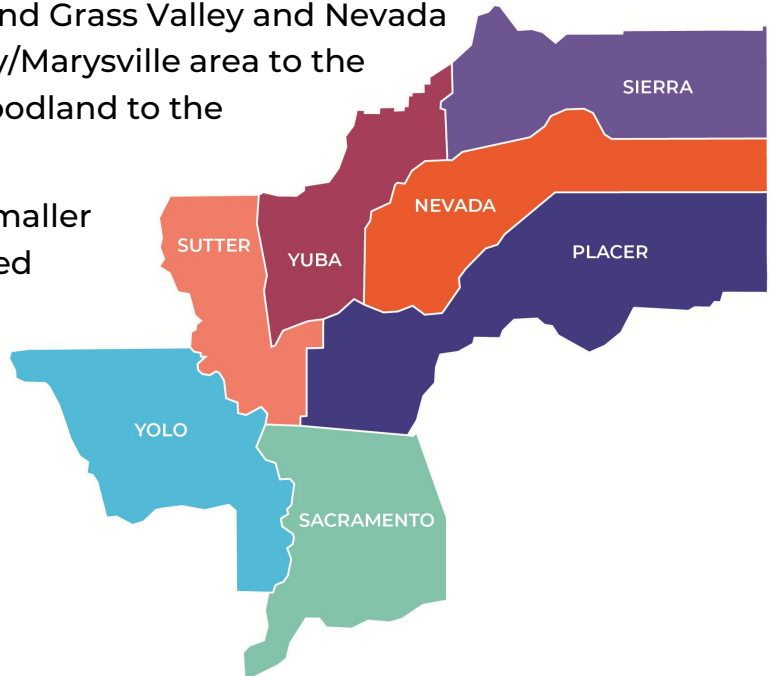

WHERE WE SERVE

Agency on Aging Area 4's service area includes several distinct urban and bedroom communities outside the Greater Sacramento region, including Auburn, Truckee, and Grass Valley and Nevada City to the east; the Yuba City/Marysville area to the north; Winters, Davis and Woodland to the west, and Galt to the south.

Finally, there are dozens of smaller townships and unincorporated areas scattered across the service area. In fact, there are more aging adults living in rural areas in Area 4 than in any other agency on aging in California (40,000+).



HOW WE CAN HELP YOU

AGING & DISABILITY RESOURCE CONNECTION (ADRC)

ADRC's assist individuals in navigating the complex choices of long-term services, support, and community resources.

CALFRESH FOOD ASSISTANCE

CalFresh Expansion helps low-income adults 60+ buy the nutritious food they need for good health. Recipients can buy food at any grocery store or farmers market that accepts EBT.

CAREGIVER RESPITE

In-home and out-of-home respite services provide a break for caregivers so they can attend to personal and recreational activities knowing their loved one is in a safe environment.

CAREGIVER SUPPORT

Caregiver support programs address the needs of family caregivers in order to maintain their health and well-being, sustain their ability to provide care, and produce better outcomes for the care recipient.

ELDER ABUSE PREVENTION

Elder abuse prevention education teaches adults of all ages how to recognize, respond, and report elder abuse.

EMPLOYMENT SERVICES

Job readiness classes prepare mature workers for a more productive and successful job search.

HEALTH INSURANCE COUNSELING & ADVOCACY (HICAP)

Health insurance counseling program provides assistance with Medicare, health insurance, and long-term care insurance.

HEALTH, WELLNESS, & FALL PREVENTION EDUCATION

Health classes help maintain or improve the physical health of persons 60+ on topics such as diabetes and fall prevention education.

HOME REPAIRS & DISABILITY MODIFICATIONS

Programs to help keep homes safe, secure, and accessible for aging and/or frail adults.

HOW WE CAN HELP YOU

INFORMATION & ASSISTANCE

Telephone operators connect adults 60 years of age and older to partner agencies and community resources.

KEY CONNECTIONS CO-LIVING

Key Connections Co-Living program aims to ensure older adults continue to have meaningful social connections. Older adult *homeowners* can age in place in the communities they cherish. Older adult *renters* have access to secure affordable housing.

LEGAL SERVICES

Legal service programs assist with civil legal needs such as legal advice, counseling, and legal representation.

LONG-TERM CARE OMBUDSMAN SERVICES

Staff and trained volunteers assist residents of long-term care facilities and their families in resolving complaints.

LUNCH SITE & HOME DELIVERED MEALS

In a social setting, aging adults can enjoy a hot, nutritious meal at a local senior center or other public gathering places.

MOBILE MEALS & RESTAURANT VOUCHERS

These programs provide alternative forms of meal service such as restaurant vouchers or mobile meals delivered via food truck.

MEALS ON WHEELS

Home delivered meals support homebound aging adults who may be unable to prepare their own meals.

OUTREACH SERVICES

One-on-one support to inform aging adults or their caregivers of existing services and benefits.

TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

Programs provide free or low-cost local transportation.
