
# Local Aging & Disability Action Plan for Yuba and Sutter counties

### What is a Local Aging & Disability Action Plan?

The Local Aging & Disability Action Plan (LADAP) is a blueprint for promoting healthy aging and supporting quality of life. The plan will allow local government, the private sector, and philanthropy to prepare for upcoming demographic changes in our older adult and disabled population.

While California has a 10-year Statewide plan, the California Department of Aging recognized the importance of engaging communities like Yuba/Sutter to develop their own, locally informed master plan for aging, called Local Aging & Disability Action Plan.

Locally, Yuba/Sutter's Local Aging & Disability Action Plan will include recommendations for improvements to housing, transportation, healthcare, Alzheimer's, Dementia, behavioral health & social support, and caregiving.
