AAA4 Staff are now finalizing contract packets for State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2019-2020. The Agency will be working to get all agreements fully executed in a timely fashion.

AAA4 does not anticipate receiving funds from the State until September 2019. Once that occurs, approved Monthly Financial Requests (MFRs) for July 2019 will be paid as soon as possible. All Funded Partners should plan appropriately.

No Funded Partner is obligated to expend AAA4 funds prior to receiving confirmation from the Agency that reimbursement is forthcoming. Nevertheless, **AAA4 requires any Funded Partner electing to temporarily suspend or reduce the provision of services on or after July 1, 2019 to notify the Agency in writing.**

Baseline Older Americans Act awards for SFY 2019-20 are shown in the charts below. The dollar figures shown originate from actual appropriations for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2019 and from estimated appropriations for FFY 2020 which currently assume no changes in funding levels.

For successful 2019-2020 RFP participants, AAA4 is awarding more funds to all recipients because more funds are available to be awarded.
